

TWICE-WEEKLY CONNECTION TO ELBA ISLAND FROM 21ST JUNE

On Saturday 21st June the airline ElbaFly will inaugurate its summer connection between the airports of Orio al Serio and Marina di Campo, on Elba Island. The flight, which will operate every Saturday and Monday until 1st September 2008 will be made by a Let 410, a twin-engine turboprop aircraft seating 17 passengers. The flight time is one hour and 20 minutes.

The first flight is scheduled from the Elba airport at 9.30am on Saturday 21st, arriving at 10.50am in Orio al Serio, from where it will depart again at 11.30am, arriving at Marina di Campo at 12.50pm. On Mondays the flight will depart from Elba at 8.50am, arriving at Orio al Serio at 10am. Take-off is scheduled from the Bergamo airport at 10.40am, landing on Elba Island at midday.

There are two exceptions in the flight timetable: Monday 23rd June, when the flight will take off from Elba at 12.30pm and arrive at Orio al Serio at 13.50pm, from where it will depart once again at 2.30pm, arriving on the island of the Tuscan archipelago at 3.50pm; and Friday 15th August, when ElbaFly will operate an additional flight for the convenience of travellers on this national holiday, following the Saturday timetable.
